**WELCOME — Fritz**

- Meeting started right at 9:00am, led by Fritz (President)

**SECRETARY REPORT — Hope Dalebroux**

- Reviewed meeting minutes from September 5th, 2020 meeting and approved by board and group. Raffle licenses, both Class A and Class B, were renewed by Hope in April with the help of Sue Sallenberg. Copies of the renewal applications are in the Secretary's binder. Was able to update a few member emails.
- Will be doing Project Spotlight posts on the Lake Association FB, so if anyone has any pictures from past projects (beach, trails, etc.) please send to Hope via email or the FB page.

## **TREASURER REPORT — Kristy Lamers**

- Beginning balance May 2021 was \$22,423.71
- Current balance as of meeting is \$22,147.97
- Winter Derby brought in \$6,705.00, minus \$1406.49 to purchase prizes = \$5298.51 profit
- Fritz motion to approve financial report, 1st by Scott, 2nd by Joe

## **WINTER DERBY RECAP — Scott Lamers**

- Temperature was -10 degrees but still successful!
- Brought in \$6705, 130 people signed up to fish
- Had to purchase all the prizes this year, about \$1400 worth
- Tried something new with the cookout by the boat landing, brats and burgers and thought that went well. It was pretty cold that day, but think if more people knew about it it would have been more busy with the food (opportunity to post more info before event via FB page and emails to members)
- Biggest opportunity—need more people to volunteer! Scott did a large majority of the prep and running of the event on his own.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

### **THANK YOU TO ALL VOLUNTEERS**

- Thank you to Steve Lamers and all volunteers who helped with fishing pier and boat launch (didn't get names but about 8+ guys)
- Steve Lamers said the wheels on the boat launch have to be moved, will be done in the fall
- Thank you to Cal Peters and others who cleared out the area around the boat launch and info kiosk, looks like a great picnic area now

## **AERATORS**

- Jim Wallen has noticed in the winter the aerator is not running as much as it should. Algae formed on the dome, will need to take the diffuser heads off on units to see if that helps. He cleans up aerators each fall, but they're clogging earlier than usual in the season so we'll need to figure out how we can avoid that

## **DNR FISH SAMPLING & STOCKING**

- Joe Hurst emailing with DNR. COVID has affected the DNR's schedule, we were supposed to get boom shock sampling in 2022 but now pushed to 2023. Recommended doing boom shock sampling before fish stocking, but we haven't stocked in a few years. Do we want to pay for our own boom shock sampling before DNR (~\$1500)?
- Jim Wallen made motion to put \$1500 towards fish stocking instead of boom shocking. 2nd by Steve Lamers.
- Group discussion on dollar amount to put towards fish stocking. Depends on prices of fish, Fritz doesn't have fall prices for fish stocking yet but should be out in a week. Will report at July meeting.
- Jim Wallen made motion to put \$3000 towards fish stocking in bluegill and crappie species, will ask for walleye prices and report at July meeting. 2nd Steve Lamers. Official dollar amount beyond \$3000 will be discussed at July meeting.

## **LAKE HEALTH ANALYSIS — JOE HURST**

- DNR did sampling of the lake earlier this spring. 70-80% is organic matter, 20-30% inorganic. Oxygen levels are high, will come back in July to sample for nitrogen and phosphorous levels. Should have analysis report for Labor Day meeting.
- Potentially another project for the association—aerators down on the south end or muck treatment pellets. Analysis went down 10-12 feet, weeds down there that haven't decomposed for about 30

years. Could drain that end and let it dry out to clean it up, but that'd be impossible due to inlets and springs. Weed cutters won't do it, dredging would be very expensive, versus another aerator for \$20K. Muck treatment pellets are \$1000 per 3 acres of pellets, about 200 acres on south end. We could do a small area to test how it works, it's recommended to do treatment pellets in aerated area.

- Grants available for a project like this. John and Dawn Lord met with Florence County Chamber of Commerce, and chamber said they're very interested in helping our association apply for grants. Scott meeting with them in a few weeks, and Joe will also contact them for help with grants.

### **KIOSK UPDATE — JIM WALLEN**

- Steve Lamers mentioned it could use a coat of paint
- There's envelopes left in the tubes but not everyone uses them, about \$100 in donations collected from the tube just from spring
- Jim will continue to work on updating the info in the kiosk
- Joe put new commercial toilet paper dispenser in the bathroom by the boat launch and filled with toilet paper. Town will maintain it and fill with TP. Nothing in bathroom by the beach, Joe said he'll purchase another commercial toilet paper dispenser for that one and have it installed by next meeting

### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### **LAKE CLEAN UP EFFORTS — Jim Wallen**

- Has noticed tires, cans, etc. in the lake. Water is super clear now, so a good time to clean it up. Don't need to plan a committee or event, just as people are out on the lake they can clean up a little

#### **SUBCOMMITTEE CREATION — Fritz**

- Need more volunteers for events, so suggested we make subcommittees to have a point person for certain things. Derbys, fishing pier removal, etc.
- Maybe we just need to send out volunteer notices sooner and have multiple FB posts to try to get more volunteers.
- Suggestions: Derby could be Scott & Kristy, Lake Health and Aerators could be Joe & Jim?
- No official motions made in regards to creating committees, just have point person for specific things:
  - Fishing Derby/Fundraisers: Kristy & Scott Lamers
  - Lake Aerators/Lake Health: Jim Wallen & Joe Hurst
  - Fish Stocking: Fritz
  - Dock/Pier Installation and Maintenance: Steve Lamers (need to find additional person)
  - Beach/Dock/Swimming Platform: Scott Lamers, Joe Hurst, Brandon Lamers,
  - Swimming Markers: Swede & John Touchett
  - Adopt a Highway Cleanup: Bob Pfaffl & Cal Peters
  - Boat Landing & Kiosk: Jim Wallen

### **SUMMER DERBY PLANNING**

- **Summer Derby will be Saturday August 14th**
- Kristy and Scott volunteered to organize event and donations
- Scott mentioned what items do well with punch board vs what doesn't do well—TV's and autographed footballs don't do well, grills, chainsaws, blowers, Laona machine donations are very popular items. Not much participation with meat raffles anymore, during Winter Derby we made more money with 1 raffle rather than having multiple raffles. Best money maker is the punch board, but we need more prizes to have enough. Recommended 2 punch boards, 1 for Friday and 1 for Saturday for the summer derby.
- Hope will email out the Donations Letter to members so other members can help gather donations for the Summer Derby

## OTHER ITEMS

- Cal Peters cleared out the Long Lake Trail last week, trail is in good shape. Idea to make pamphlets to talk about the trail that we could leave at Roadhouse, General Store, Grandma Sally's, etc. Cal said if we make a brochure, we include info about the whole community and the Lake Association. Hope & Erika will work on brochure, plan to have complete end of June so we can hand out at 4th of July parade.
- Fritz wasn't sure if we were due for elections at this meeting, he technically was completing Sissy's term as President. Hope & Joe were just elected last year due to vacancies as well, and Kristy's seat isn't up until 2022. Jim Wallen made motion to let elections roll until next year, Steve Lamers 2nd.
- Jim Wallen renewed the Lake Association's incorporation registration with the Dept of Financial Institutions 12/4/2020.
- Guillette family will make parade float to represent Lake Association for the 4th of July parade this year
