REVIEW UPDATED BYLAWS

- Reviewed the proposed changes to the bylaws that we made at the special board meeting last October (see attached Bylaws with highlighted changes)
- Jim Wallen made a motion to accept the changes to the bylaws, 2nd by Dominic Petit

SECRETARY REPORT

- Hope updated the FB page to "Lake Association of Long Lake - Florence County WI" since we get a lot of messages with people confusing us with another Long Lake. Sue S. suggested we include Forest County as well since part of the lake is in that county, have to wait 60 days before updating FB page name again but will do that
- Hope filed our annual Incorporation renewal in January, also renewed our raffle licenses early in May
- Hope reviewed Fall meeting minutes, Kristy L. made a motion to approve the meeting minutes, 2nd by Erika B.

TREASURER'S REPORT

- Winter Fishing Derby brought in \$8550.00, minus prizes purchases = grand total of \$6,654.00
- Current bank account balance \$34,234.74
- Joe H. made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report, 2nd by Scott L.

OLD BUSINESS

WINTER FISHING DERBY RECAP

- 193 people registered for the Winter Fishing Derby, which smashed any previous record of participants
- Doug B. has Long Lake cups for sale, \$25 a piece
- Sissie S. challenged all members to bring a donation worth at least \$25 to the Summer Fishing Derby
- All donations can be given to Scott L, either his shop by the boat landing or house on Long Lake Rd.
- Make sure prize items are new items

NEW BUSINESS

SUB-COMMITTEES

- Joe H. and Fritz will make a list of subcommittees to form and recommend leaders at the next meeting - ideas so far include Public Relations Committee (formalize a little more in how we express what we're doing with the association, working with other local committees and organization for grants and other funds), Beach (clean up and maintain, kiosk), Derbies (Scott & Kristy), Boat Landing, etc.

BIG 4+ SPORTSMAN DONATION

- Scott and Kristy L. will be in charge of donating to the Big 4+ for their events and also gather donations from them for our events

SUMMER FISHING DERBY

- Saturday August 12th, 2023
- Should purchase a tent for backup if it rains, that way we don't take up Roadhouse tables, Steve L. made a motion to spend up to \$1000 on a covered tent (16x24 runs about \$500-\$700+), 2nd by Clete C., Scott L. will take care of purchasing tent
- Dominic P. asked about our accountability for keeping our assets, where are they stored? Everything Lake Association owns is at Scott's shed (docks, banners, volunteer vests, etc.). We should make a list of our assets to stay organized

GRANT STATUS

- We've been working with White Water Associates for over a year, our grant wraps up at end of this year
- Doing surveys on oxygen levels, weeds, etc. To date - found that sediment on south end is majority organic, no contaminants. Also did studies this winter, oxygen is low like it is every year but not as low as it was last year, had no winter kill this year so nothing unusual about oxygen readings
- Continuing to do oxygen texts this summer, they'll finalize report findings and publish it to us. When that's concluded, we'll apply for the next grant to get additional funding for whatever the next project is to restore the south end of the lake
- The weed growth has been extensive over the last few years, but it's a cyclical weed so we hope it hit its peak last summer and should start to recede (7 year timeline)
- Joe H. will let the group know the next time they need volunteers for grant activities

FISH SURVEY / STOCKING UPDATE

- Netted a few nights on the lake, 4 nets out 2 nights in a row and went in 4 different locations in the lake. Primary object was to estimate abundance for northern, yellow perch, and black crappie populations
- Too many bullheads in the lake (2719 caught), too many northers (761 caught, 15 adult northern per acre, rest of the county has 2.9 per acre)
- Steve L. suggested we offer a prize for catching the most of those species at the Summer Fishing Derby, 1 prize for whoever gives in the most or do it by pounds or even do a separate tournament for bullhead
- Sign in Crandon that says if you catch a bullhead, do not put it back in the lake, so Scott L. is looking at getting a sign made up and would need approval for that in the future
- There are also grants that help rid the lake of bullhead, so we can look into that as well.

OTHER ITEMS

- Denise, secretary from Friends of Long Lake Fire & EMS board, came to the meeting to introduce their board and let us know what they're about. This year the parade/picnic fundraiser will be on July 1st. Main portion of everything will be at the fire dept, but they'll have the UTV raffle, kids games, basket raffles, etc. at the ballpark. Can purchase UTV raffle tickets at most local businesses in Long Lake, UTV is out at Roadhouse.
- Cal P. - This year he had new people helping clear the Long Lake trail this spring. They'll be putting a sign-in ledger at the head of the trail soon
- Clete C. - Putting buoys down to south end so everyone takes one trail to south end to help cut up some weeds, will install those in the next few weeks.
- Dominic P. - Asked more people to use the Violet Trail more often, that foot traffic helps keep the trail from overgrowing and then it's less work to maintain
- Doug B. - Asked if The Store is sold, sounds like that closes at the end of June and they'll continue selling bait and a wider selection of items as well
