SECRETARY REPORT – Hope D.

- Reviewed meeting minutes from summer meeting, Rob B made a motion to approve, 2nd by Joanie R

TREASURER’S REPORT

- Account balance is \$35,570.74

OLD BUSINESS

- Scott will be purchasing the tent for the fishing derby prizes soon

FISH SURVEY REPORT

- Scott talked to the people who were doing the fish survey earlier this year and the true results/status will not be known until winter when they give us the full report
- The data we have now (see Fritz email) is the summary, Hope will post on FB page

SOUTH END CHANNEL

- Clete C. put buoys in the south end to create a channel for people to use, a lot of people are asking what they are so we talked about having signage down at the kiosk
- Hope can also post on the FB page about the buoys so people know to use that channel, not avoid it

GRANT STATUS UPDATE – Joe H.

- Have a report from White Water Associates that outlines all tasks associated with the grant and specifies what tasks we’ll need to have White Water do (WWA) or us (LLAL). Grant officially finishes at the end of this calendar year
- Second page of report is a picture of the lake, aerial shot, that shows invasive species (purple loosestrife is only one in lake) spots marked in pink. Goes into bloom in a month or so, and then we can go out and remove them (take a bag over top of bloom, cut the plant off, don’t yank/pull, to contain all the seeds in the bag, then dispose in dumpster or burn in campfire)
- Best way to get rid of other weeds in the lake is manual by raking them out, but weeds are already dwindling in some areas where it was heavy last year
- White Water compiled sample of all different heavy metals that are typical in the lake, luckily all metals are either undetected or within normal range
- Next step is dissolved oxygen measurements in July, Scott V was out doing water clarity measurements last week as well, lake has cleared up a lot from Memorial Day already which is normal for his recommendations

- Next grant is open/available starting in September, we have to submit in November. Currency consulting with DNR and Army Corp of Engineers, this would be a bigger project because there's a lot to do on the south end, it's not something we would do alone as a Lake Association, we'll need considerable assistance with
- The end game with this current grant is to use the data to create a lake study/management plan that outlines the state of the lake today, how we can address any issues found through these studies, and establish a baseline with the data to address future issues in the lake. We also have to maintain data year to year to keep the baseline up to date, then the DNR and the Army Corp of Engineers are more willing to help us in the future to improve the lake, recover the south end, help change fish population, help with weeds, etc.

- Maintaining Boat Landing & Beach - owned by the town but we have a big hand in that, Bob Pfaffle, fishing pier, boat landing installation, getting people to help and set dates to take care of that

- Public Communications - different than public relations, help write and promote/verbalize what we do and do it on a regular basis, publication in the local papers, post on FB, email, submitting something once a quarter or twice a year
